Bulletin Board: Howard Salles After more than two years of global pandemic, Passover is the holiday we so desperately need – an opportunity to reflect on where we've been, how far we've come, and where we have yet to go. As we retell the story of our Exodus from Egypt, so too do we recall our current journey through this long period of isolation and change.

Our stories of the past year echo the story of our people; we remember the struggle against oppression then and now, and we commit ourselves to continuing to pursue a more just and compassionate world as together we say l'shanah haba-ah bi-Y'rushalayim, next year in Jerusalem. This year, finally, we can be together in person – perhaps some of you with family and friends at home, and perhaps some of you with our wonderful congregation, right here at Temple Israel.

What makes this Passover different from all others? "Passover is z'man cheruteinu, time of our liberty — time of freedom," we say. "And especially for Ukrainian Jewry, and for Ukrainians, this is a time of hard kept liberty."

In the Passover story, Moses demands that Pharaoh "Let my people go." There is certainly a thread connecting ancient Egypt to modern-day Ukraine.

Ukrainian Jews started their liberation 3,000 years ago, and they still are in the process. The past century of this struggle has been especially difficult for Ukrainian Jews. There have been massacres, pogroms and, of course, the Holocaust, and now a war with Russia. We pray for the people and continue to find ways through a multitude of organizations to help our brethren struggling so desperately in Ukraine.

Cantor Riselle Bain's Message Continued

If there ever was a year that we can experience the message of Passover, it is right now. Ukraine is in rubble, as the smoke billows from the carnage of destruction. A modern-day Pharaoh is trying to enslave 43 million people because his hunger for power is insatiable.

Each and every one of us can be a modern-day Moses, despite a Red Sea of challenges that may seem insurmountable to cross over. All we need is a pure realization that God is here, and we are God's partners in creating tikkun olam. We are in this world to make a difference, and each and every mitzvah that we do asserts our freedom that no Pharaoh can possibly stifle.

On April 15 after nightfall, we all have the ability to connect to the same God who saved our ancestors of old by eating matzah – the same bread of affliction and the bread of our freedom which sustained us 3,334 years ago – and will sustain us now, as we leap, plunge, and charge forward, leaving the shackles and servitude of yesterday behind us.
