First and foremost, I want to thank this wonderful congregation for being so supportive to me at this time, as my husband, Michael, is undergoing major surgery on March 2nd.

Our March 3rd Purim Service/Celebration will not happen in our sanctuary. BUT NEVER FEAR, IT CAN STILL HAPPEN!!

I will be back with you for our March 17th Shabbat service. We will have an abbreviated service because we have a very special guest speaker, thanks to Phyllis Behrens. I hope you will all be with us in person or online to hear the story of Kailla (Carrie) Gersten Gutman. The following is a little background about her interesting life.

Kailla (Carrie) Gersten Gutman was born on November 9,1944 in Kazakhstan, Russia, six months before WWII ended in Europe and six years after Kristallnacht. Carrie is called "a child of the Holocaust and Survivor". Her children are 1st generation survivors.

Carrie's parents, Lerb and Podja Gersten, stayed in Russia for 18 months until her father had enough money to bribe the Russian border guards to let them pass. Her parents put baby Carrie in a cart pulled by four oxen. They put down a layer of straw, then Carrie, and then another layer of straw. Carrie remembers her parents telling her not to cry.

The Irgun, the then Palestinian underground, in Stettin, Poland was comprised of French, Americans, Russians and British. They got the family out late at night by hot wiring anything with wheels. The family wound up in the American sector of Berlin, Germany, called Schlosshausen. Here, they stayed in wooden Army barracks. After that, they stayed outside of town in a one room house that hadn't been damaged by the war. They had a coal stove, a table and chairs and two beds, an outhouse and a pump for water outside. This housing was too expensive, so the Americans moved them out.



Cantor Riselle Bain's Message Cont.

Carrie's sister, Anna Gersten, was born in the American hospital in 1947. Russia blockaded the food in the American sector of Berlin. The family was airlifted out by American helicopters.

They were taken to Frauenwald, Germany, near Frankfurt. They stayed in Germany for 5 ½ years. A friend of Carrie's father had a tailor shop in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. The family settled in Philadelphia where Carrie's father worked as a tailor.

Carrie graduated Magna Cum Laude from Temple University in 1970 on a full scholarship. She then went to Bryn Mawr College for a Masters Degree in social work, graduating in 1972, again on a full scholarship.

Carrie married Michael Gutman in 1969. She and her husband now live in Atlanta, Georgia. Their two children both work as doctors with MD/PHD degrees. They also have 4 grandchildren.


