Since the October 7th attacks, Passover takes on a new, somber significance, prompting Jews to reflect on the current suffering in Israel and the hostages while remembering the Exodus and its lessons of freedom and redemption.

As we prepare to celebrate Passover, we find ourselves in uncharted territory. We celebrate freedom during Passover, but what is the definition of freedom this year? We still feel the pain from the horrors of October 7, and the events both in Israel and in the United States. We still pray for our hostages, and we are left with many questions, and not many answers. That does feel particularly appropriate to Passover, as the asking of questions along with answers is central to the Seder. How are we thinking about the definition of freedom this year? How do we read the Jewish liturgical poem in the Haggadah Vehi She'amdah. The phrase "Vehi She'amdah" is a key part of the Passover tradition, reminding Jews that throughout history, God has always been there to protect them from enemies. The poem serves as a reminder of the Jewish people's resilience and God's unwavering protection, even in the face of adversity, which emphasizes God's promise to protect the Jewish people. And yet, we continue to see on a daily basis those who "seek our destruction"? What is the meaning in L'shanah Haba'ah B'Yerushalayim?

My friends, I doubt we can answer with assuredness all those questions, but we can still be so grateful right here at Temple Israel to have the freedom to gather together as friends and family and to celebrate our history and to probe to find answers as to how we can be responsible for the betterment of our and the world's future – Tikkun Olam! I look forward to sharing our special Haggadah with you and bringing you all in as participants, as our Temple Israel Seder is truly your Seder!


