## Cantor Riselle Bain's Message

#### Dear Congregants,

As we begin this month of May 2025, Israel is about to celebrate her 77<sup>th</sup> birthday. The State of Israel was established on May 14, 1948, and her Independence Day – in Hebrew, Yom Haatzmaut – is celebrated according to the Hebrew calendar on the 5th day of the month of Iyar. This year, the 5<sup>th</sup> day of Iyar falls on Saturday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>.

It is widely believed that Hitler's policy of genocide against European Jews during World War II and the catastrophe of European Jewry during World War II had a decisive influence on the establishment of the Jewish state in 1948. For the Jews, the Holocaust triggered a supreme effort toward statehood, based on the belief that only a Jewish state might again avoid the horrors of the 1930's and 1940s. For the nations of the world, shocked by the horror of the extermination and burdened by feelings of guilt, the Holocaust convinced them that the Jews were entitled to a state of their own.

Nevertheless, the political plight of the Jewish people at the end of WWII had not diminished. "They were stateless, powerless -- pawns in the struggle between nations.

Having no country of their own, they were unable to assert their political selfinterest or self-defense. Instead, they were forced to rely on others to act on their behalf."

But on May 14, 1948, when the British formally ended their mandate, Zionists in Palestine declared an independent state of Israel, changing everything. After fighting and winning their war of independence, Jews returned to their historical homeland, longed for, for over 2000 years, victims no more.

Also, during the month of May, we will continue chanting the daily count of the Omer, which began the second day of Passover and will culminate with the festival of Shavuot from June 1-3, 2025. After 49 days, our ancient ancestors finally arrived at Mount Sinai and received the Torah. The symbolic "countdown" from Passover to Shavuot tells us that our freedom from slavery was not complete until we received the Torah, which gives our lives purpose and meaning.

We find our Jewish calendar during the month of May filled with historical and spiritual significance!


