### Cantor Riselle Bain's Message September 2025 / 5785 - 5786

As September begins, we are in the Hebrew month of Elul, the last month of our Hebrew calendar. Soon we will arrive at the month of Tishrei, which marks the beginning of a new year -5786 – and we will begin our High Holy Days together as we celebrate Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur.

One addition to our services this year will be Selichot. <u>Selichot</u> (which literally means "forgiveness") are penitential prayers recited before and during the High Holidays and other fast days throughout the year.

Like other activities during the month of <u>Elul</u>, these prayers offer an opportunity for personal reflection and to seek forgiveness from those we may have wronged during the year just ending. Immediately before the *selichot* service, it is customary to change the Torah covers to those specifically designed for the High Holidays. The special covers are usually white, representing purity and the wish that through repentance, our sins will be made white as snow (Isaiah 1:18). We will do this together during our Temple Israel Selichot service.

Among Ashkenazi Jews, and in many Reform congregations, *selichot* services (sometimes spelled *s'lichot*) are held late on the Saturday night before Rosh HaShanah. Because Shabbat has ended and a new week has begun, this time is considered particularly auspicious for penitential prayers.

This year Temple Israel will incorporate Selichot into our preparatory services for the High Holy Days on Saturday, September 13<sup>th</sup>. We will be slightly flexible with the time, because our Selichot Service will take place at the regular time of our Continuing Jewish Education class, which is 10 am in the morning! We can take comfort in the fact that Shabbat has ended in Israel, since they are seven hours ahead of us here in the United States EST. We will just imagine that we are in Israel! We will have a delicious Oneg after the service.

Of course, music is also a part of the *selichot* experience as well, and the same special *nusach* (musical melodies and modes) used throughout the High Holidays that you have become accustomed to hearing for the High Holy Days also are used during *selichot* services. These special melodies set the mood for us, as we reflect on the past year and whatever changes we wish to make on ourselves – through teshuvah – in the coming year.

Our whole Temple Israel congregation is invited to join us for this special service.

Shanah tovah u'metukah, a good and sweet year to you.




