Cantor Riselle Bain's Message



Giving Thanks in Judaism -- Hoda'ah

Tis the season for giving thanks. So, as we prepare to gather with friends and family for turkey and stuffing and apple pie, what is the Jewish concept of giving thanks?

In Jewish tradition, the connection between *hoda'ah* (gratitude) and *chesed* (loving-kindness) is fundamental and inseparable. Gratitude is not merely a passive emotion but an active force that is expressed through action. Acknowledging the goodness bestowed by God and others creates a powerful impulse to extend that same goodness to the world.

Hoda'ah begins with an inner recognition of blessings (hakarat hatov), such as being alive or having food. This inward reflection leads to an outward response of kindness toward others. A grateful heart evolves to a generous heart.

A core Jewish principle is *imitatio Dei*—imitating the attributes of God. Since God's world is built on kindness (*chesed*), humanity is tasked with doing the same. By performing acts of loving-kindness, humans give back to God in a way that is most pleasing. Gratitude for God's creation, provisions, and continued benevolence is most genuinely expressed by acting as a partner in that creation.

Today, the traditional Jewish concepts of *hoda'ah* (gratitude) and *chesed* (loving-kindness) are expressed through a wide range of contemporary practices. Modern practices of *hoda'ah* focus on cultivating a mindset of gratitude, which science confirms improves mental and emotional health.

Following the ancient Jewish practice of saying 100 blessings a day, many people keep a daily journal to record blessings or positive things that happen. One popular technique for families is listing "three good things" every night.

The first prayer upon waking, *Modeh Ani* ("I thank") is already an ancient practice of immediate gratitude. It is a short prayer that immediately expresses gratitude to God for restoring the soul for another day. In a modern context, this can be expanded to include other personal affirmations of gratefulness upon waking.

Saying a blessing (*bracha*) before a meal or in response to a beautiful sight helps integrate these rituals into our busy lives.

In Judaism, gratitude is not passive but demands a response. This means translating a thankful heart (*hoda'ah*) into acts of kindness (*chesed*) and charity (*tzedakah*). Giving to others is a primary way of thanking God for one's own blessings.

So, let us cultivate the mindset to recognize these special moments not only during the season of Thanksgiving, but let us continue to integrate Hoda'ah into our lives every day. Thank You, God!




